

9. Finance - (2 Posts)

For appointment to a position in this section, an intern must have the following minimum requirements:

- a) Bachelor's degree in any of the following areas: Commerce (Finance Option), Economics, Business Administration, Business Management or Finance.
OR
Any other Bachelors degree with Certified Public Accountant II (CPA II) qualification; and
- b) Be computer literate.

10. Central Planning and Project Monitoring -(2 posts)

For appointment to a position in this section, an intern must have the following minimum requirements:

- a) i) A Bachelor's degree in Economics or Economics and Mathematics or Economics and Statistics from a recognized University/Institution.
OR
ii) A postgraduate Degree/Diploma in Economics from any recognized institution or Master's Degree in the fields in (i) above; and
- b) Be computer literate.

Other requirements that successful interns will be required to have are:

- a. A valid Police Clearance Certificate (Certificate of good conduct) from Directorate of Criminal Investigations;
- b. Personal accident insurance to cover for personal risks lasting for at least six months;
- c. Medical insurance cover by the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF) or any other reputable medical insurance firm;
- d. Copy of National Identity Card (ID) or copy of Passport;
- e. A copy of PIN certificate from Kenya Revenue Authority; and
- f. Recommendation letter from the Institution.

All the applicants must fulfill the requirements of Chapter 6 of the Constitution on leadership and Integrity. Equal opportunities will be accorded, and therefore people living with disabilities, women and those from marginalized areas are encouraged to apply.
